• Serged Spaghetti Strap made Fast and Easy!

Fabric: All the fabrics I use on **It's Sew Easy TV** come from <u>Vogue Fabrics</u> **Patterns and Sewing Supplies:** <u>The Angela Wolf Pattern Collection</u>





Creating spaghetti straps with the serger couldn't be easier.

- Measure the length you want your spaghetti strap, and cut a strip of fabric 1 inch wide by the length of the strap.
- 2. Serge a chain stitch longer than the length of the spaghetti strap.
- 3. With right sides together, line up the raw edge of the spaghetti strap with the knife on the serger.
- Before serging, insert the long chain inside of the spaghetti strap making sure to keep the chain to the far left - away from the knife.
- 5. Serge the entire raw edge of the spaghetti strap.
- 6. Remove spaghetti strap from machine.
- Gently pull the chain stitch, and feed the right side of the spaghetti strap through.
- 8. Press.

That's it! This is a simple way to make straps of any size. One tip, if the spaghetti strap is real narrow take sure to use a slippery fabric like charmeuse or satin.
