- Embroidery on Tulle Fabric

**Fabric:** All the fabrics I use on **It's Sew Easy TV** come from [Vogue Fabrics](#)  
**Patterns and Sewing Supplies:** [The Angela Wolf Pattern Collection](#)



Embroidery on Tulle Fabric can be used for a variety of things for garments and home dec.

Here I am using my [Evelyn pattern](#) and sewing the sleeves out of tulle. Tulle is fairly simple to embroider on as long as you treat the fabric very gently (as it tears easily) and choose the right stabilizer:

### Stabilizer & Hooping:

- Water soluble mesh fabric
- Hoop the fabric into the hoop with the stabilizer
- Do not use spray adhesive or sticky back stabilizer

### Needle

- #12 standard embroidery needle or #12 ballpoint

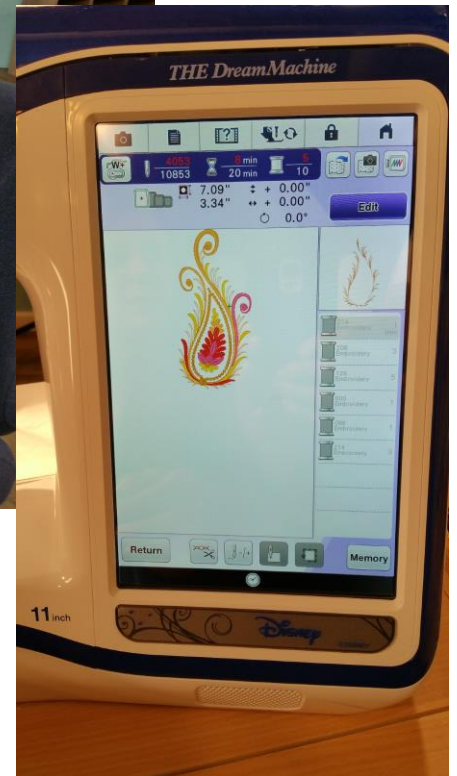
### Thread

- Rayon
- Metallic
- Silk

### Bobbin Thread

- Use a color the same as the upper thread

The trick is to chalk mark or thread baste the outline of the sleeve, but don't cut out the sleeve until you have finished embroidering.
