Quick Restyling Tip: Moving Pockets Around

Moving pockets around on a jacket is a simple way to update a jacket. First you need to check and see if the fabric is worn, torn, or faded underneath the pocket. Gently tear out a few stitches at the base of the pocket, it you don't see fading or damage then go ahead and remove the entire pocket.

Move the pocket around until you like the new look. For this jacket I choose to set the pockets on an angle. You can either re-attach the pocket by handstitching or us the "blind hem" stitch on the sewing machine. If the jacket has lining, you will need to open the lining at the hem enough to get the sewing machine into the jacket. After attaching the pocket by machine, close up the lining.
