
In the Hoop Eyeglass Case

Materials

8" x 8" hoop Tear-away stabilizer Quilted fabric: one 7" x 5"; one 2" x 5" and one 5" x 8" One 6" zipper

Hoop tear-away stabilizer in the $8" \times 8"$ hoop. Stitch color I, a center line for positioning the coil and the outline of the finished eyeglass case.



Place the 2" x 5" fabric strip over the small rectangle, keeping the fabric edge just below the long horizontal line.





Stitch color 2, the tackdown of the small rectangle.



Place the 7" \times 5" fabric strip over the large rectangle, keeping the fabric edge just above the long horizontal line.



Stitch color 3, the large rectangle.



Place the zipper on the long horizontal line, centering the coil right on the line.





Tape the ends beyond all stitching. Keep the ends of the zipper OUT of the stitched rectangles.



Stitch color 4, the decorative stitches.

Place the 8" \times 5" fabric strip right sides together with the stitched rectangle. Make sure the large rectangle covers the outline.

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Stitch color 5, the two-ply outline.



Remove the tape. Open the zipper keeping the tab away from the stitched rectangle (at the sides).





Remove from the hoop, tear away all excess stabilizer. Use scissors to cut away the stabilizer behind the zipper.

Trim the corners and turn right side out.
