



How to embroider on a cloth diaper/cloth diaper cover

Method:

- trace pattern onto template plastic, transfer all marks from pattern
- cut template out
- trace pattern onto diaper cut, transfer all elastic and closure marks from pattern to fabric
- using a straight edge ruler draw a horizontal line through the back elastic leg marks
- using a straight edge ruler draw a vertical line at the pattern center
- take a full scale print out of design to determine placement on back of diaper cover
- match center from design print out to center of intersecting lines on diaper cut, raise or lower design for best placement
- mark center of design onto diaper cut
- hoop PUL
- float PUL and stabilizer under hoop
- start stitching design
- cut out diaper cover
- trim stabilizer close to design
- fold up scrap piece of PUL over embroidery back, pin edges
- using sewing machine stitch the scrap of PUL closed, be sure to keep diaper cut out of the way
- trim scrap of PUL close to stitching
- finish diaper/diaper cover as per your patterns instructions
- run finished product through a hot dryer for 20 minutes to seal the PUL at the stitching
