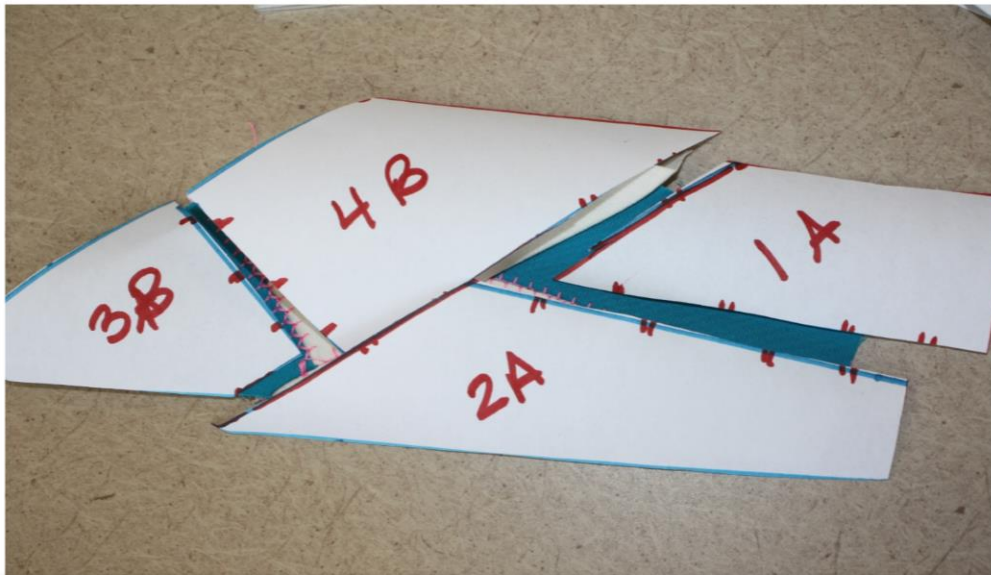

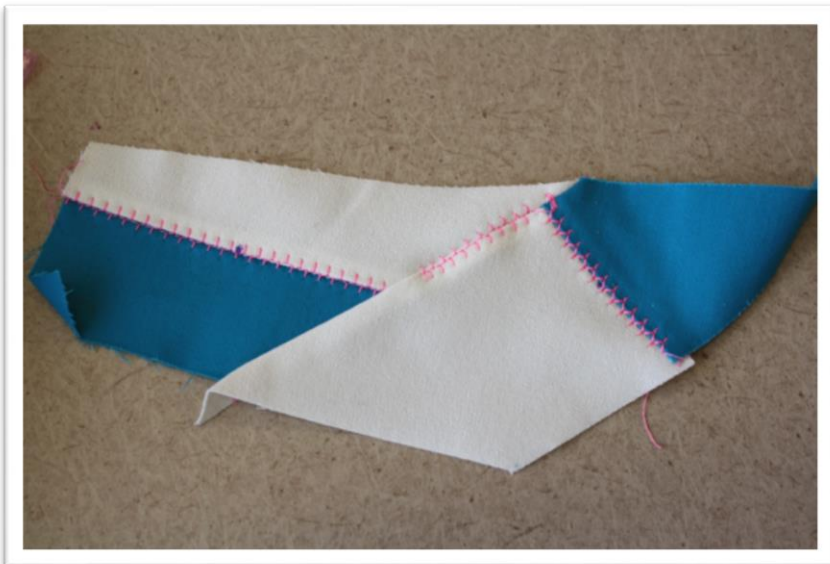
Color Blocking is a great way to create unique fabric or redesign a simple garment!

- Sketch a design with straight lines or curves.
- Add hashes across new seams.
- Number pieces and take a photo so you can remember how to get the fabric back together.
- Add grainline to each piece.
- Cut fabric either as separate pattern pieces or cut with a rotary cutter along each line. (if cutting fabric from pattern without adding seam allowance, be sure to cut fabric much larger as the width and length will get smaller after quilting.)

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- Sew pieces back together starting at the bottom of the design. Only stitch full seams!
- For example in the previous photo:
 - Sew 2A to 1A
 - Sew 3B to 4B
 - Sew the top of 2A/1A to bottom edge of 3B/4B
