

Season 813 The Me Decade – the 1970's

- The embroidered peasant blouse

Fabric: All the fabrics I use on *It's Sew Easy TV* come from [Vogue Fabrics](#)

This top is so easy to sew, but you can use these tips for any loose fitting top:

- Cut out the fabric and mark the location for each embroidery design.

This top is made from a lightweight rayon fabric. Other great fabrics would be cotton broadcloth, chiffon, linen, charmeuse, to name a few.

I used water soluble, sticky back stabilizer. After I embroidered each piece, I sewed the garment together and threw it in the wash. All the stabilizer disappears!



For the sleeves create a band for the elastic:

- Cut a strip twice as wide as the elastic.
- Serge the raw edges
- Fold under the seam allowance on each side, press.
- Pin in place onto the wrong side of the sleeve, just about 3" above the hemline.
- Stitch the band in place.
- Insert elastic.
- Pull elastic to each seam, stitch in place, then sew the entire seam closed.
